## **Our Mission:**

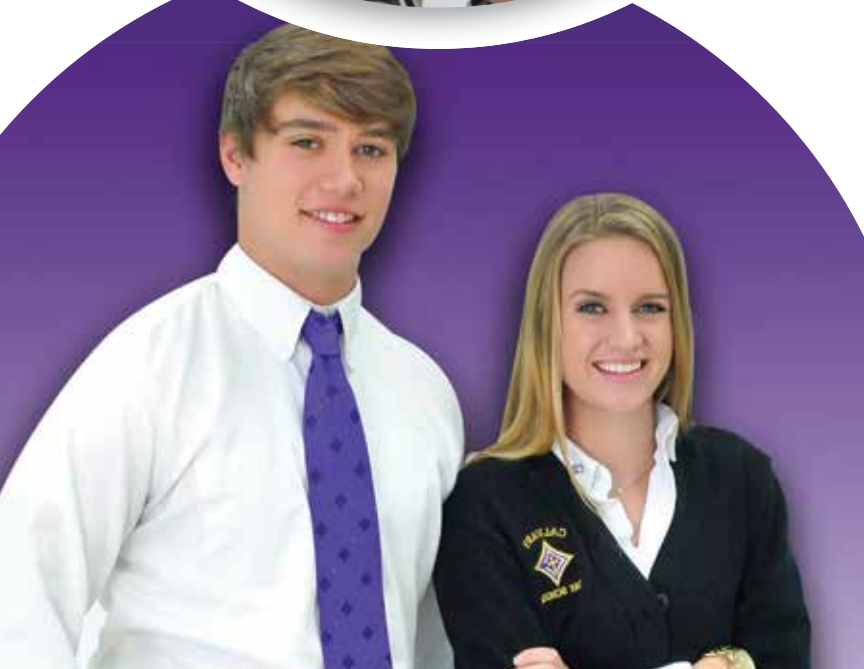
